



WOGA GYMNASTICS (FRISCO) SUMMER CAMP INFO

June 1 - August 14, 2020

Summer is here and we are thrilled to be able to welcome our campers back to WOGA! We have missed our families are thankful for your return.

WOGA Frisco Camp will be following state and local guidelines, and will be operating at 25% of capacity at this time. To ensure that we remain within the allowable number of students in the building, and to help facilitate proper distancing, we are needing to implement a few changes to how camp typically runs.

Here are some of those changes that you can expect and prepare for:

Registration: At this time, our FRISCO customers **MUST** pre-register for camp. We have a limited number of people allowed in the building and this will help us to keep a balanced ratio. This will also limit waiting in line at the front desk, keep contact to a minimum, and cuts down the amount of time parents need to spend in the lobby. The Walk-in option is not currently available and camp may fill to the designated capacity.

AGE limit: Campers must be ages 4 and above. We are optimistic that we will be able to welcome our little 3 year-olds back very soon! They just have a harder time understanding social distancing and what is expected.

Front Door Drop off procedure: Each morning upon arrival to camp, all campers will be checked for fever before they are permitted in the building

(anyone showing symptoms of illness will not be able to participate in camp activities)

According to Health Protocol established by Governor Abbott we are asking parents to keep a 6 foot distance between individuals that are not coming from the same household. If possible, please do not enter the gym other than to drop off or pick up. For check-in we will have parents enter the lobby using the door to the right, by the vending machine. There will be a table for temperature scans and sign-in. For dismissal, we will have parents enter the lobby using the door to the left, by the elevator, and proceed to file into rows that we have designated and marked for proper distancing. We will call your camper out of the gym while you sign out.

Groups: Campers will be put into equal groups according to age. Camp will have limited number of kids in each group. We are flexible to allow friends or siblings to be in the same group so long as they are not too far apart in age. If your child wants to be in a group with a friend or sibling, please let us know in advance.

What to bring: Water bottle, lunch, snack and/or money to buy snacks from the vending machine. All water fountains will be turned off and we will not be able to provide a drink or snack for them. Each camper must have their own lunchbox. Siblings also need to have separate lunch boxes as it is possible they will not eat lunch at the same time or in the same room. There will be no access to refrigerators or microwaves.

Sanitation procedures: WOGA Camp coaches will be wearing masks whenever they are in close proximity to our campers, such as when spotting, or assisting with lunches. Campers will be given hand sanitizer upon entering the building and before going home, as well as after each of the rotations. Sanitizer dispensers are located throughout the building for staff, students, and parents to use as often as they wish. Several times throughout the day staff will wipe down and sanitize surfaces such as tables, chairs, doorknobs, and high-touch areas.

The entire gym is being disinfected at the end of each day. In addition to thorough daily cleanings, WOGA has partnered with *Xtreme Hygiene* to provide a weekly X-Guard Virucidal Misting Treatment on all contact surfaces in our facility. X-Guard is an EPA Registered Disinfectant and

Virucide that is safe, non-toxic, and gentle enough for use anywhere. This spray is residual, so it will provide lasting protection between treatments.

Additional Notes:

We will be practicing to minimize person to person contact, including maintaining 6 feet of separation from individuals. Understandably, as we are dealing with children, there may be a momentary situation where this is breached or not feasible. The health and safety of our students is our top priority.
