



WOGA GYMNASTICS SUMMER CAMP INFO

June 1 - August 7, 2020

WOGA Camp will be following state and local policies, and will be operating at 50% of capacity at this time. We would like to encourage our customers to pre-register for camp in order to help us balance the ratio.

What to bring: **Water bottle ,lunch, snack** and/or money to buy snacks from vending machine.All water fountains will be turned off.Each camper must have their own lunch box. Siblings may NOT share one lunch box as they may not eat lunch at the same time or in the same room. There will be no access to refrigerators or microwaves.

Front Door Drop off procedure: Each morning upon arrival to camp, all campers will be checked for fever before they are permitted in the building (anyone showing symptoms of illness will not be able to attend)

According to Health Protocol established by Governor Abbott we would like to ask parents to keep 6 feet distance between individuals that are not coming from the same household. If possible do not enter the gym other then at the drop or pick up time.

We will use Front door for entrance and campers will be released through the side door and line up on the designated spots outside of the gym for parent's pick-up.

Groups: Campers are put into equal groups according to age.

Camp will have limited number of kids in each group.We are flexible to allow friends or siblings to be in the same group so long as they are not too far apart in age. If your child wants to be in a group with a friend or sibling, please let us know in advance.

Staff: All WOGA Camp coaches will be wearing masks whenever they are in close proximity to the campers, such as when spotting or assisting with lunches. Camper will be given hand sanitizer after entering the building and before going home, as well as after each of the rotations. Sanitizer dispensers are located throughout the building for staff, students and parents to use as often as they wish. Several times throughout the day staff will wipe down and sanitize surfaces such as tables, chairs, door-knobs and etc. The whole gym is being disinfected at the end of each day .

COVID 19 Info:

We will be practicing to minimize in-person contact, that includes maintaining 6 feet of separation from individuals. When maintaining 6 feet of separation is not feasible, other methods will be utilized to slow the spread of COVID-19, such as wearing a face covering or mask, washing or sanitizing hand frequently, and avoiding sharing utensils or other common objects.

The entire gym is disinfected at the end of each day. In addition to thorough daily cleanings, WOGA has partnered with *Xtreme Hygiene* to provide a weekly X-Guard Virucidal Misting Treatment on all contact surfaces in our facility. X-Guard is an EPA Registered Disinfectant and Virucide that is safe, non-toxic, and gentle enough for use anywhere. This spray is residual, so it will provide lasting protection between treatments.
